

Hospital Access Monitor Positions Available!



Hospital Access Monitors are responsible for temperature and symptom screening patients, visitors, caregivers, and vendors who enter the ministry. In addition they also provide mask(s) to any entrants who do not have one. Hospital Access Monitors will have education and training on current guidelines and will be required to review updated materials as guidance is updated.

Hospital Access Monitors will be required to wear company-provided Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

Temporary Position Details

- These are temporary positions with expected end dates. The temporary assignment is expected to last between 3 and 6 months as we consider the advice of the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) and other guidance.
- The temporary roles will be considered internal caregivers and will be allowed to apply for and be considered for other openings within Providence.
- These positions are benefits eligible for those above a .5 FTE.
- The pay range is between \$15 and \$19 per hour depending on experience.
- Positions are available in 3 shifts (day, evening, and night).
- Assignments will be scheduled to be at a specific ministry (hospital) to the best of our ability to minimize commute disruption. However, there may be limited times when an adjustment is needed.
- Positions are available across the state of Oregon including in Seaside, Hood River, and Medford as well as throughout the Portland Service Area.
